

Delphi Salaried Retirees Seek Help

The Delphi Salaried Retiree Association (DRSA) has been fighting for several years to protect the pensions and benefits of Delphi salaried retirees. While General Motors and Delphi have supported union-represented retiree pensions through the long process of Delphi's bankruptcy, Delphi salaried retirees have seen their health benefits slashed, and their pensions turned over to the Pension Guaranty Benefit Corp. (PGBC), which has caused severe reductions in pensions for many salaried retirees.

DRSA is challenging this governmental action through the courts and in Washington D.C. The outcome of these legal and political activities could represent a landmark in treatment of pensioners across the entire Automotive Industry and beyond.

"The premise of our entire effort, both legal and political, is that Salaried Retirees deserve fair and equitable treatment with other groups of retirees. Delphi Salaried Retirees are facing discriminatory treatment," according to [Den Black](#), interim chair of DSRA.
